ASSOCIATE OF ARTS DEGREE IN MUSIC

Beginning with Fall 2015, students at Dalton State will be able to earn an associate's degree in music. This will allow students interested in pursuing music as a career to begin their college journey at DSC. The program of study is designed to mirror as closely as possible the curriculum for a four-year music degree and includes applied instrument and/or voice lessons, large ensembles (choir and band), and music theory, along with music appreciation, American music, and world music.





COURSES

If you are interested in pursuing a bachelor's degree in some branch of music such as music education or music therapy, an associate's from Dalton State can start you on that road. Music students are able to complete required courses in music theory and one-on-one study on their instrument, as well as gaining valuable experience by performing with Dalton State's own large ensembles, the band and choir.

Music Theory I and II
